**NOTICE OF DECISION**

USDA Forest Service  
Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest  
Ogden Ranger District  
Rich County, Utah

On September 30, 2009, Acting Ogden District Ranger Rick Hopson made a decision to authorize livestock grazing on the Woodruff and Dairy Ridge Cattle Allotments.

The decision will manage the two allotments together as three pastures (two in Woodruff and one in Dairy Ridge) with two of the three pastures deferred each year on a rotational basis.

The decision implements an adaptive management strategy that includes the following: a grazing season generally between July 1 and September 15; a deferred rotation grazing system; intensity of grazing use to Forest Plan standards and guidelines; and monitoring to indicate when adjustments in management are needed. The decision includes construction of a drift fence and water improvements.

The Decision Notice and Environmental Assessment may be reviewed at the Ogden Ranger District, 507 25th Street, Suite 103, Ogden, Utah 84401. Electronic copies of the Environmental Assessment and the Decision Notice are available on the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest website.

This decision is subject to administrative review (appeal) pursuant to 36 CFR Part 215. The Appeal Deciding Officer is Forest Supervisor Brian Ferebee.

The office business hours for those submitting hand-delivered appeals are: 8:00 to 4:30, Monday through Friday, excluding holidays. Electronic appeals must be submitted in a format such as an email message, portable document format, rich text format (.rtf), and Word (.doc) to:

In cases where no identifiable name is attached to an electronic message, a verification of identity will be required. A scanned signature is one way to provide verification. Only individuals or organizations who submitted comments during the comment period specified at 215.6 may appeal this decision. The notice of appeal must meet the appeal content requirements at 36 CFR 215.14.

Appeals, including attachments, must be filed within 45 days from the publication date of the legal notice in the Ogden Standard Examiner, the newspaper of record. **Attachments received after the 45-day appeal period will not be considered.**

The publication date in the Ogden Standard Examiner is the exclusive means for calculating the time to file an appeal. Those wishing to appeal this decision should not rely upon dates or timeframe information provided by any other source.
