## ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR

## OUACHITA NATIONAL FOREST

ORDER NO. OA-CS-01-2006

**FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROADS**  
**AND**  
**USE OF VEHICLES OFF NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROADS**

PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF 16 U.S.C., SECTION 551 AND 36 CFR 261.50 (a) AND (b), IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT THE FOLLOWING ACTS ARE PROHIBITED ON THE AREA, ROADS AND TRAILS DESCRIBED IN THIS ORDER AS, **HOGAN MOUNTAIN WALK-IN TURKEY HUNTING AREA** WITHIN THE OUACHITA NATIONAL FOREST and is shown on the attached map.

**THE FOLLOWING PROHIBITED ACTS ARE SET FORTH IN 36 CFR 261.54 AND 261.56:**

261.54(a) Operating any motorized vehicle on national forest system roads within the closed area

261.56 Operating or possessing a motorized vehicle off national forest system roads

PURSUANT TO 36 CFR, SECTION 261.50 (e), THE FOLLOWING PERSONS ARE EXEMPT FROM THIS ORDER:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

**NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROADS AFFECTED BY THIS ORDER ARE: 285, 875 AND 286.** Portions of these roads shall remain open year round. The description is as follows:

| <u>ROAD NAME</u> | <u>NUMBER</u> | <u>LENGTH</u> | <u>TERMINI</u>   |
|------------------|---------------|---------------|------------------|
| Harvey           | 285           | .2 Mi.        | FS 141 to MP .2  |
| Jack Pigeon      | 875           | 1.7 Mi.       | FS 141 to MP 1.7 |
| Pigeon           | 286           | 3.2 Mi.       | FS 141 to MP 3.2 |

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions 36 CFR part 261, Subpart A.

THIS ORDER WILL EXPIRE FIVE (5) YEARS FROM DATE OF EXECUTION
