Enclosed you will find a copy of my decision authorizing livestock grazing on National Forest System lands within the Bountiful, Blake Hollow, Little Monte, and Dry Bread Sheep Allotments (referred to as the Monte Cristo Area Sheep Allotments). A copy of the Environmental Assessment (EA), upon which this decision is based, is also provided. Electronic copies of the Environmental Assessment and the Decision Notice are available on the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest website. I encourage you to take this opportunity to read the Decision Notice and the Environmental Assessment.

This decision is subject to appeal pursuant to Department of Agriculture regulations at 36CFR 251, subpart C. Any appeal of this decision must include the information required by 36 CFR 251.90, including the reasons for appeal. If you appeal this decision, a Notice of Appeal must be postmarked or received by the Forest Supervisor, Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest, 8236 Federal Building, 125 South State Street, Salt Lake City, UT 84138, within 45 days of the date of this letter. A copy must be simultaneously sent to the District Ranger, Ogden Ranger District, 507 25th Street, Suite 103, Ogden, Utah 84401.

You will notice that a different appeal regulation is shown in the attached Decision Notice. The appeal regulation at 36 CFR Part 215 applies to anyone who submitted comments or otherwise expressed interest during the review period. The appeal regulation at 36 CFR Part 251(as explained in the paragraph above) applies to permit holders only. Please be aware that permit holders who submitted comments during the comment period are eligible to appeal under either regulation, but not both.
