



**ORDER NO. 18-56
v.2007.2**

**OFF ROAD VEHICLE USE
WILLAMETTE NATIONAL FOREST
MCKENZIE RANGER DISTRICT**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area described in this order within the Willamette National Forest, McKenzie Ranger District. This special order will become effective at the time of signature, will be in effect from November 1st through May 15th annually, and will remain in effect until rescinded.

Use or possession of a motor vehicle off forest development roads. **36 CFR 261.56**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
2. Any Federal, State, or local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Owners or lessee's of land in the area.
4. Persons engaged in a business, trade, or occupation in the area.

DESCRIPTION OF AREA:

This Order is in effect on all lands comprising the HooDoo Ski Area, (See Attached Map, Exhibit A).

EXCEPTION: Designated snowmobile trails and parking areas within the affected area.
