ORDER 10-01

Occupancy and Use Restrictions

Pursuant to Title 16 U.S.C. § 551, and Title 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited on a portion of National Forest System Lands within the Salida Ranger District of the San Isabel National Forest, Chaffee County, State of Colorado, hereinafter referred to as the Restricted Area as shown on attached Exhibit A. This Order is necessary to provide for public health and safety and to protect ski area permitted property.

PROHIBITIONS:

Going into or being upon the Restricted Area while possessing or using a motor vehicle, including snowmobiles. 36 C.F.R. § 261.53(e) and (f)

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- Any person with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- Any Monarch Mountain Ski and Snowboard personnel carrying out their official duties.
- Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This Order will be in effect from the date of signature and shall remain in effect until rescinded, or until midnight December 31, 2011.

Violations of this prohibition are punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C §§ 3559 and 3571).
