Land Management Plan Correction

June, 2008

I am making some corrections and updates to the Kaibab National Forest Land Management Plan as described below. No change in the size, force or effect of any Plan component is intended with these corrections.

Land Area Names

We are renaming some land management areas to update terminology and correct some past errors with the term “Ecosystem Management Area”. The map on the next page shows this correction. While the terminology is changing, the numbering of Plan areas from the current Plan is retained for ease of tracking.

Many large vegetation management projects use a particular “landscape” as the area of analysis associated with a particular proposed action. We are adding these to the Forest Plan maps to show their relationship with Plan areas.




Figure 1. Display of land area name changes. The current Plan uses the legend on the left. The corrected Plan will use the legend on the right. (See table for abbreviation definitions.)
