ROAD and AREA CLOSURE
Silver Creek Bridge #1 Rehabilitation
For Public Safety during a Construction Project

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the National Forest System road and area described in this order, within the administrative boundaries of the Emmett Ranger District, Boise National Forest. This Order will be in effect from May 3, 2010 through June 16, 2010, or until project is completed and signing is removed by Forest Officers.

1. Being on the road (as described below). **36 CFR 261.54(e)**
2. Going into or being upon the area (as described below). **36 CFR 261.53(e)**

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local law enforcement officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.
4. Construction contractor (C.L. Heilman Company, Inc.) and their employees and agents while doing work related to the bridge rehabilitation project.

AREA and ROAD DESCRIPTION

The closed area is described as the area within a 500 foot radius from the point where National Forest System (NFSR) Road #671 crosses over Silver Creek located within Township 11 North, Range 5 East, Section 2, NE ¼ Section, Boise Meridian. A segment of NFS Road #671 within that area radius is also closed. The area and road is within the Emmett Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Boise Meridian, Gem County, ID.

PURPOSE


The area and segment of road, as described above, must be closed to all public access to provide for public safety and protection during the construction and rehabilitation of the

Silver Creek Bridge #1 during the contract period of May 3, 2010 through June 16, 2010, or until project is completed and signing is removed by Forest Officers.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order will be in effect from May 3, 2010 through June 16, 2010, or until project is completed and signing is removed by Forest Officers.
2. A map identifying the above-described area is attached to and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of this order is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six months [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
4. This Order supersedes any previous orders/notices for the above-described roads or portions thereof.

Assessment of Need and Enforcement Plan
 Emmett Ranger District – Boise National Forest
 Order #0402-06-27

1. Background. A contract has been awarded to C.L. Heilman Company Inc. for the construction and rehabilitation of the Silver Creek Bridge #1 located on the Silver Creek Road. This site is located on National Forest System Road (NFSR) # 671 which is on the east side of the Emmett Ranger District. Construction will start on May 3, 2010 through June 16, 2010, or until project is completed and signing is removed by Forest Officers. Area and road closure section of NFSR #671 will begin on May 3rd, 2010.

2. Intent of Subpart B order. This temporary area and road closure is for all motorized access and foot traffic to promote public safety during rehabilitation of the Silver Creek Bridge #1, located on NFSR # 671.

3. Enforcement Plan. On ground signing and maintenance of signs at the junction of NFS road #698 and #671 and at NFS road #671 and Silver Creek CG to advise the public of temporary road closure and alternate routes during bridge construction. On site signing to advise the public of the area that is closed to entry will be posted. On site FS administrative personnel will make compliance contacts as needed.


