ROADS - NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM (NFS)

- NFS Roads - Suitable for Passenger Cars
- NFS Roads - Suitable for Passenger Cars (Rough Surfaces)
- NFS Roads - Open to All Vehicle Classes * (Highway Legal & Highway Non-Legal)
- NFS Roads - Short Base 4WD
- NFS Roads - Closed Routes or Decision Signed for Closure

ROADS - OTHER JURISDICTION

* Roads maintained for high clearance vehicles; seasonal closures may apply.

PROPOSED ACTION:

PROPOSED NFS-MOTORIZED ROAD/TRAIL ADDITIONS

- Roads - Open to All Vehicle Classes * (Highway Legal & Highway Non-Legal)
- Trails - Motorized, less than 50 inches

SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

Restrict use below the high-water mark at Shasta Lake and Trinity Lake (within the Shasta-Trinity National Recreation Area) to only highway legal vehicles and provide a maximum speed limit of 15 mph.

AREAS

- Closed to Vehicles
- Vehicle Restriction Area

- National Forest System Land
- National Forest Wilderness
- Non-National Forest System Land
