Griffin Creek Resource Management Project
OPEN HOUSE - Monday, April 12

The Tally Lake Ranger District of the Flathead National Forest is hosting a public open house on Monday, April 12 from 3:00pm to 7:00pm at the Tally Lake Ranger District office, 650 Wolfpack Way in Kalispell to share information about the proposed Griffin Creek Resource Management Project.

The proposed project is located in the Griffin Creek drainage north of Marion, Montana. The purpose of the project is to improve forest tree structure and species composition, reduce hazardous fuels, improve recreation opportunities, maintain and improve wildlife habitat and security, reduce sediment and improve water quality and aquatic habitat, and provide wood products for the local economy.

Comments about the proposed project are encouraged to help determine issues of concern, level of analysis needed, and possibly develop alternatives to the proposed action. Comments should be forwarded to the Tally Lake Ranger District by April 19.
