

# Bitterroot National Forest 2010 Mushroom Program



## COMMERCIAL PERMITS

- Commercial harvest area is within the Gird End Fire perimeter.
- Mushrooms collected under a commercial permit are intended for resale.
- Unlimited amount of mushrooms harvested and in possession.
- Commercial permits are available for purchase only at the BNF Supervisor's Office and the Darby Ranger District Office.
- Permit only valid for the Bitterroot National Forest Gird End Fire.
- Permits are sold on a graduated scale:
  - 7-day permit = \$20.00
  - 14-day permit = \$40.00
  - 21-day permit = \$60.00
  - 30-day permit = \$75.00
  - Season Permit = \$100.00
- Camping permits will not be issued to commercial pickers. Normal dispersed camping rules will be enforced.
- All commercial harvesters 12 years of age or older will be required to purchase a permit. Parent or guardian's name will be included on the minors permit.
- Minors must be accompanied by an adult guardian when collecting, transporting, or selling mushrooms.
- Motorized travel is restricted to open roads and OHV designated trails. Know the rules before going off-road.
- Use a knife to cut or break the mushroom's stem off at ground level.
- Do not rake or use other ground disturbing activities when collecting mushrooms.
- To help minimize the spread of noxious weeds it is highly recommended to wash your vehicle before entering and exiting National Forest Land.
- Human waste must be buried 8 inches and 300 feet away from any road or water source.
- Permit fees are non-refundable.
