The Forest Service will receive sealed bids in public at Stanislaus National Forest, Supervisor's Office, 19777 Greenley Road, Sonora, CA 95370 at 10:00 AM local time on 05/24/2010 for an estimated volume of 231 CCF of Incense Cedar sawtimber, 8133 CCF of Ponderosa/Jeffrey Pine sawtimber, 108 CCF of Sugar Pine sawtimber, and 252 CCF of White/Red Fir sawtimber marked or otherwise designated for cutting. In addition, there is within the sale area an estimated volume of 2102 CCF of Combined Softwood non-saw that the bidder agrees to remove at a fixed rate. Sale contains specified roads with an estimated public works construction cost of \$118,020.29. Bidders qualifying as small business concerns under the Small Business Act may, when submitting a bid, elect for the Forest Service to build permanent roads. Additional information concerning this option is in the prospectus. The Forest Service reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
