

ORDER NO 99-2

WILDERNESS AREAS

SAN BERNARDINO NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the San Jacinto, San Gorgonio, Cucamonga, and portions of the Sheep Mountain Wilderness Areas on the San Bernardino National Forest.

1. Riding, hitching, tethering or hobbling a horse or saddle or pack animal in violation of posted instructions. 36 CFR 261.58(aa)
2. Using a trail, campsite, or other area by a group larger than twelve persons. 36 CFR 261.58(f)
3. Exceeding the maximum group size of 12 people per permit. 36 CFR 261.58(f)
4. Possessing more than 8 pack stock. 36 CFR 261.57(b)
5. Grazing of packstock. 36 CFR 261.57(e)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order.

1. Any Federal, State or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. person(s) with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited activity.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR, Part 261, Subpart A and prohibitions in Forest Order #3.
