

ORDER NO. 77-4 WILDERNESS AND PRIMITIVE AREAS

CALIFORNIA REGION

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b) the following is prohibited on any area or forest development road on trail under my jurisdiction:

1. Parking or leaving a vehicle in violation of a posted sign 36 CFR 261.58(g).
2. Parking or leaving a vehicle outside a parking space assigned to one's own camp unit within a developed recreation site. 36 CFR 261.58(h).
3. Possessing, parking or leaving more than two vehicles, except motorcycles or bicycles, per camp unit within a developed recreation site. 36 CFR 261.58(i).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), each of the following persons is exempt from this order:

- Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR, Part 261.
