

ORDER NO.5
ROADS AND TRAILS
SAN BERNARDINO NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) each of the following acts are prohibited on the identified areas under my jurisdiction:

1. Operating a motor vehicle on the following Forest Development Roads which may be closed periodically between November 1 through May 1 for resource protection and public safety. 261.54a

3. Possessing or operating a mountain bike or motorized vehicle on: 261.54a

a. Pinyon Trail 5E02 261.55b

b. Black Mountain Trail 2E35

c. Cahuilla Mountain Trail 2E45

4. Operating a vehicle in violation of the California Vehicle Code. 261.54d

5. Operating/possessing a motorized vehicle off a Forest development road, route or trail. 261.56

6. Operating/possessing a motorized vehicle on any Forest development road, route or trail, except those designated as open for the following uses:

a. The following routes are open to all vehicle traffic properly registered by the State of California:

3N24, 3N21, 2N47, 3N22, 2N30, 2N40, 3N89, 3N59A, 2N02, 2N74y-1, 2N70Y, 2N17x, 2N33, 2N36, 2N37, 2N34, 3N11, 3N03, 2N61Y, 2N74Y, 2N28Y, 2N29Y, 2N27Y, 3N10, 3N34, 3N34D, 3N17, 3N03F, 2N73Y-1, 2N75Y, 3N53

b. The following routes are open to All Terrain Vehicles and Motorcycles, properly registered by the State of California.

3N06V, 3W11, 3W12, 3W13, 3W14, 1W17, 2N12, and Cactus Flats Staging Area.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), each of the following persons is exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. person(s) with authorization or a permit.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR, Part 261.
