Spring Mushroom Permits on Sale at the Goosenest Ranger District

Yreka, CA — The Goosenest Ranger District on the Klamath National Forest is now offering mushroom permits for sale.

Spring mushrooms include, but are not limited to, morels, boletus, shaggy mane and puff balls. Spring mushrooms do not include matsutake mushrooms. This year, three permits are available: a 10-day, non-consecutive permit for \$20; a 30-day permit for \$50; and a seasonal permit for \$100. These permits are valid for both personal and commercial use.

Permits available on the Goosenest Ranger District (3 miles south of Macdoel, CA on U.S. Highway 97) are valid only on the Klamath National Forest, Goosenest Ranger District lands. These permits are not valid on private lands.
