

Huron-Manistee National Forests
Conner's Marsh Pipeline, Change of Ownership and New Permit Project
April, 2010

The Huron-Manistee National Forests received a request for a change of ownership of the Conner's Marsh pipeline and associated right-of-way from MichCon and DTE to DCP Assets Holding, LP (DCP). DCP purchased the pipeline in November, 2009. The project also includes issuing a permit for a new term, 50 years, instead of issuing a permit for the remainder of the existing term that expires December 31, 2010.

The proposed new term request is to allow the continued occupancy and maintenance of the same pipeline and right-of-way on the Mio Ranger District, Huron-Manistee National Forests. It is located in T25N, R2W, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, section 10; E $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$; sections 15, 22, 27; SW $\frac{1}{4}$, section 34; and T25N, R2W, W $\frac{1}{2}$ W $\frac{1}{2}$, sections 3, 20, 15, 22, 27, and 34, South Branch Township, Crawford County, Michigan.

Both proposals are administrative requests only, no changes or major repairs are being proposed.
