Big Bear Greenthumbs Native Plant Restoration Volunteer Program Schedule 2005

Big Bear Valley, CA.....For the past decade the San Bernardino National Forest has been conducting ecological restoration projects on the Mountaintop District. The Big Bear Ranger Station Native Plant Nursery has a commercial-size greenhouse, a shade cloth structure, a seed storage facility, and a tool shed, all managed by volunteers and/or private grant funding. With these facilities, the District has grown and out-planted thousands of native plants and enhanced hundreds of acres of habitat for wildlife, federally listed plants and animals, and other degraded lands.

The U.S. Forest Service is seeking volunteers who enjoy working outdoors and have an interest in working in our nursery program and out on the Forest for our native plant restoration program. Activities will include site preparation, seed collection, germination, plant propagation, and out-planting

of potted materials. Work will vary month to month as seasons and weather change. We will be working in the greenhouses and out on the Forest. Workdays will last from 9:00am to around 3:00pm on the second to last Saturday per month. The volunteer group will meet in front of the Big Bear Ranger Station at the flagpole. **Dates include March 19, April 16** (Earthday is the 22!), **April 23, May 21, June 18, July 16, August 20, September 17, September 24, October 15, October 22, and November 12.**

Volunteers should bring a sack lunch, water, sunscreen, hat, jacket and work gloves if you have them.
