

## Volunteer/Adopt a Trail

Routes that are designated through the travel management process will require monitoring and maintenance. We—the U.S. Forest Service (Ouachita National Forest)— will need your help maintaining existing motorized trails (those administratively designated for motorized use) and open roads. You can help minimize trash along roads and trails—pack-it-in, pack-it-out! You can encourage other riders to “tread lightly” on the land by avoiding wet areas, staying out of streams and rivers except to cross at designated crossings, and avoiding eroded trails. You can help by monitoring the condition of roads and trails and reporting problems to the appropriate ranger district office (ask for the “ORA”). And you can join or form a group of volunteers that “adopts” a trail or section of road.

Volunteer groups will take some time to organize, and after groups are formed, volunteers will be required to sign a designated "Volunteer" form (FS 1800-7). We encourage you to indicate your interests on the form below and return it to us. Thank you.
