

# HIGHWAY 14 CORRIDOR

**All forest roads are mountain roads with potential hazards. Appropriate caution is absolutely necessary. It is a good idea to pack a chainsaw in case you encounter downed trees and debris in the road.**

222	Dixie (Highway 14 to Dixie)	Open	6/28/20	Pavement to within 4 miles of Dixie, then gravel on steep, narrow hill. Maintained yearlong by Idaho County.
222	Mackey Bar (Dixie to Mackey Bar)	Open	6/28/20	Gravel road; rough in places. Switchbacks and narrow road with turn outs. <b>Last 10 miles recommended for 4X4 low range. No trailers.</b>
233	Crooked River (Highway 14 to Orogrande Town Site)	Open	6/28/20	Well-maintained gravel road. Narrow and windy in some parts along Crooked River with limited turnouts. <b>Be aware of ongoing large truck traffic.</b>
233	Orogrande Town Site to Orogrande Summit	Open	6/28/20	Rough and rutted, very steep in some areas. <b>No trailers recommended.</b>
233	Orogrande Summit to Del Rio Mine and Jumbo Camp at end of corridor	Closed – See Condition Column	6/28/20	ATV's only recommended when open. <b>Really rough.</b>
2331	Orogrande Summit to Wildhorse CG	Closed	6/28/20	<b>Closed due to snow.</b>
234	Red River Hot Springs	Open	6/28/20	Spring driving conditions. Maintained by county; good gravel road.
244	Lightning Creek	?	6/28/20	Gravel and native surfaces.
279	Cove	?	6/28/20	Gravel and native surfaces.
283	Table Meadows	Open	6/28/20	Table Meadows Road into Elk City. Gravel and native surface road.

284	Elk City Wagon Road	Open	6/28/20	Gravel and native surfaces.
307	Elk City Wagon Road Extension	Closed	6/28/20	Connects with Newsome. Gravel and native surfaces. <b>Administrative Closure Order</b>
309	Hungry Ridge	?	6/28/20	Gravel and native surfaces; spring break-up conditions
311	Orogrande to Penman Hill/Dixie	Closed	6/28/20	Gravel and native surfaces.
421	Whitewater	Open	6/28/20	Gravel and native surface road with steep grades and narrow roadway with turnouts. <b>Very rough &amp; rutted from Vista Point down. No trailers recommended.</b>
443	Limber Luke	Open	6/28/20	From Elk City to Limber Luke Campground and the junction with Road 464 at the district boundary. Good gravel road.
443	Falls Point	Closed indefinitely due to slides.	6/28/20	<b>Administrative Closure Order</b>
464	Boundary	Open	6/28/20	From the junction with Road 443 at the northern district boundary, along the northern boundary to the junction with Road 284. Good gravel road.
469	Peasley Creek	?	6/28/20	Gravel and native surface road with steep drop offs.
484	Fischer-Placer	Open	6/28/20	Native surface road. Big boulders have been removed.
492	Santiam	Open	6/28/20	Rough gravel road.
648	Lower Cougar	?	6/28/20	Gravel and native surfaces.
649	Silver Leggett Creek	Open	6/28/20	Gravel and native surfaces.

650	Lower Clear Creek	Open	6/28/20	Gravel and native surfaces.
651	O'Hara	Open	6/28/20	Gravel and native surfaces- average forest road.
1103	Cayuse Connection	?	6/28/20	Gravel and native surfaces.
1105	Cougar Creek	?	6/28/20	Gravel road.
1106	Sears Creek/ Green Creek	?	6/28/20	Gravel road.
1150	Moose Butte	Open	6/28/20	Accessible to locked gate. Native surface road; some small slumps, but nothing major.
1172	Soda Creek	Open	6/28/20	Gravel and native surfaces. Possible trees down.
1183	Blanco	Open	6/28/20	Gravel and native surfaces.
1190	Trapper Creek Grade	Open	6/28/20	Road 222 to Red Mailbox. Gravel; steep and one lane in many places.
1190	Dixie Summit to Red Mailbox	Open	6/28/20	Good gravel road; narrow in places.
1199	Elk City to Newsome	Open	6/28/20	Good gravel road; one lane and steep in places.
1803	Wheeler Mountain	Open	6/28/20	Good gravel road.
1808	Elk City Wagon Road	Open	6/28/20	Elk City to Newsome. Good gravel and native surfaces. Narrow in places.
1858	Newsome	Open	6/28/20	Highway 14 to Lytle Cow Camp at Road 464. Good gravel road.
2009	Grouse Creek Connection	?	6/28/20	Gravel and native surfaces. Be aware of logging operations.
9816	Deadwood	Open	6/22/18	Generally, good gravel and native surface road.

## **Forest Road Check List**

- ✓ Watch for & obey posted speed limits. Forest Service roads can be narrow, rocky, & not meant for high speeds.
- ✓ Be careful braking on gravel roads. Allow more time and distance when coming to a stop.
- ✓ Beware of rocks, boulders, road washouts, downed trees and brush on the roadway.
- ✓ Use appropriate tires for the terrain and conditions you'll be traveling.
- ✓ Remember to stay on authorized roads.
- ✓ Plan appropriately for food, gas, and lodging, which may not be readily available along Forest Service roads.
- ✓ Always carry extra food and water.
- ✓ Always let someone know your plans and stick to those plans.
