

NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROAD RESTRICTION  
ARAPAHO & ROOSEVELT NATIONAL FORESTS  
PAWNEE NATIONAL GRASSLAND

Pursuant to Title 16, United States Code, Section 551, 36 Code of Federal Regulations (“C.F.R.”), Section 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited on the described National Forest System Road located on the Clear Creek Ranger District of the Arapaho National Forest in Clear Creek County, Colorado. (the “Restricted Road”)

The Restricted Road is defined as National Forest System Road 701.2 (Loch Lomond Road) located in T. 2 S., R. 74 W., Section 33 and T. 3 S., R. 74 W., Sections 3 and 4, and includes all portions of National Forest System Road 701.2 above the first gate just outside of the Town of Alice (or includes all portions of National Forest System Road 701.2 above the second gate if the first gate is open). The Restricted Area does not include the parking area below the first gate nor portions of National Forest System Road 701.2 below the first gate. The Restricted Road is shown on the attached map hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A. This Order is necessary to provide short-term resource protection.

**PROHIBITIONS:**

Using any motorized vehicle on the restricted road between the following dates (36 C.F.R. 261.54(a)):

Upper gate: October 15 – July 15 (10/15 – 7/15)  
Lower gate: December 1 – June 1 (12/1 – 6/1)

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Persons engaging in winter motorized recreation using over-the-snow vehicles such as snowmachines or snowcats;
- 2) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty;
- 3) Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

This temporary order will remain in effect until rescinded or until March 31, 2008.
