Forest Service to surface the Harris Park Road

(Douglas, Wyo.) May 18, 2010 – The Forest Service plans to apply gravel to the surface of the Harris Park Road, which is located east of the Esterbrook Lodge. This project will be accomplished during the spring and early summer as weather permits.

The Harris Park Road is in the Medicine Bow-Routt National Forests, which is administered by the Douglas Ranger District.

Please be advised that road maintenance season is upon us. Visitors may encounter road maintenance in other parts of the Medicine Bow-Routt National Forests and Thunder Basin National Grassland, as well.

Gravel surfacing is planned on approximately three miles of the Harris Park Road. Work will be performed during weekdays to minimize interference with public use of the road. Visitors should contact the Douglas Ranger District at 307-358-4690 prior to visiting. Project schedule updates and progress reports will be available for this and any other road maintenance projects in the area.
