

TRAILHEADS

FOUR PEAKS WILDERNESS

Not uncommonly one of the more challenging parts of a backcountry trip is attempting to find the trailhead itself. To assist you in reaching the jumping-off place, we have developed the following directions to the trailhead named below:

Cane Spring TH - A 4WD vehicle is required to reach this trailhead, but travel is not recommended for any type of vehicle. From Mesa, drive north on State Highway 87 (the "Beeline") to Four Peaks Road 143; this is approximately 11.5 miles north of the Verde River Bridge and just past the Desert Vista Rest Stop. Turn right and go approximately 2.5 miles to Road 401. Turn right and drive 4.4 miles to Cottonwood Camp. The road turns to 4WD-only beyond here for another 5.8 miles to Cane Spring. Trails accesses: **Cane spring Trail 77, Alder Creek Trail 82.**

Be sure to secure your vehicle, and don't leave valuables in sight while you gone. Also be sure someone knows where you are going.
