

**Administrative Correction 1 August 18, 2005**

Administrative corrections are defined at 36 CFR 219.7(b) and may be made at any time and are not plan amendments or revisions.

Administrative corrections include the following: (1) Corrections and updates of data and maps, (2) Corrections of typographical errors or other non-substantive changes; (3) Changes in the monitoring program and monitoring information (4) Changes in timber management projections; and (5) Other changes in the Plan Document or Set of Documents, except for substantive changes in the plan components.

**Plan Chapter 1 (36CFR 219.7(b)(2))**

Forestwide Standards and Guidelines; page 1-54 under Recreation - Dispersed; Guideline 2 reads: " Close designated groomed over-the-snow routes (roads or trails) to wheeled vehicles unless the use is permitted."; and Forestwide Standards and Guidelines; page 1-60 under Infrastructure - Travelways; Standard 5 reads exactly the same: " Close designated groomed over-the-snow routes (roads or trails) to wheeled vehicles unless the use is permitted."

Originally in Draft Medicine Bow Forest Plan this wording was located under Recreation as a Standard but between draft and final it was modified based on public input and moved to Infrastructure. During editing, we did not remove it from Recreation and should have.

Therefore there should only be one standard with this wording and it should be listed under Infrastructure – Travelways. The Recreation – Dispersed Guideline 2 should be deleted and the guidelines renumbered. New pages 1-54 and 1-55 attached.
