

ORDER
OCCUPANCY AND USE RESTRICTIONS
WHITE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST, ASPEN RANGER DISTRICT

Pursuant to 36 CFR Sec. 261.50(a) and (b), for restoration and rehabilitation the following are prohibited within 100 feet of the constructed trail and campsite located on National Forest Land within the North 1/2 of the North 1/2, Section 29, Township 10 South, Range 84 West, 6th P.M., Aspen Ranger District, White River National Forest, until further notice:

1. Travel on the trail by any means (36 CFR 53(f)).
2. Cutting or damaging any live vegetation (36 CFR 53(f)).
3. Moving soil or rock (36 CFR 53(f)).
4. Cutting and/or moving any dead wood (36 CFR 53(f)).
5. Camping at the campsite near the end of the trail (36 CFR 261.58(e)).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from the prohibition contained in this order: 1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission; 2) Any federal, state, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty. The location of the trail and campsite are illustrated on the below map.
