

ORDER
SPECIAL RESTRICTION
WHITE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to Title 16 USC Section 551, and Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on National Forest Lands within the area described below, and as shown on Exhibit A of this order within the White River National Forest in Garfield County, Colorado. This Order shall be in effect until rescinded or until December 31, 2013.

PROHIBITIONS:

- 1) Possessing or transporting an animal, including dogs on the Hanging Lake Trail, NFST 1850. (36 CFR 261.58(s))
- 2) Entering or being in Hanging Lake, including swimming and wading. (36 CFR 261.58(k)).
- 3) Camping within ¼ mile of Hanging Lake. (36 CFR 261.58(e))
- 4) No campfires within ¼ mile of Hanging Lake and within a ¼ mile corridor either side of the Hanging Lake Trail, NFST 1850. (36 CFR 261.52(a))
- 5) Shortcutting switchbacks on the Hanging Lake Trail, NFST 1850. (36 CFR 261.55(e))

EXEMPTIONS:

- 1) Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2) Any Federal, State, or local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- 3) Persons being aided by a service dog.
