

ORDER

SEASONAL ROAD CLOSURES

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited on the roads described in this order within the White River National Forest until further notice.

- 1) Using a motor vehicle on Forest Development Roads on the Holy Cross District, White River National Forest. Specific roads, time of year, and conditions this act applies to are listed below (36 CFR 261.54 (a)).

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
- 2) Any Federal State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue team or firefighting force in the performance of official duty.

The following roads will be closed to motor vehicle use except snowmobiles operating on snow, annually from April 1 to July 1 (36 CFR 261.54 (b)).

Cortina Lane - No. 781 - From the gate in Section 14 above West Vail to its end in Section 10, all in T.5S., R.81W.

Lost Lake Road - No. 786 - From the gate at its junction with the Red Sandstone Road in Section 25, T.4S., R.81W., to its end.

Moniger Road - No. 701 - From the gate at its junction with the Red Sandstone Road in Section 22, T.4S., R.81W., to the gate above Muddy Pass in Section 29, T.3S., R.82W.

No Name Road - No. 705 - From the gate in Section 4 to the start of the four-wheel drive section of the road in Section 19, all in T.7S., R.80W.

Peterson Jeep Road - No. 724 - From the gate near Homestake Creek in Section 30, T.6S., R.80W., to its end in Section 35, T.6S., R.81W.

Ranch Creek Jeep Road - No. 755 - From the gate near its junction with the East Fork of the Eagle River Road in Section 23 to its dead end in Section 13 all in T.7S., R.80W.

Red Sandstone Road - No. 700 - From the gate on the road where it enters the Forest boundary in Section 1, T.5S., R.81W., to its end in Section 12, T.4S., R.81W.

Resolution Road - No. 702 - From the gate in Section 10, T.7S., R.80W., to Ptarmigan Hill in Section 29, T.6S., R.79W.

Cottonwood Road - No. 402 - Beginning at the Forest boundary in Section 14, T.2S., R.82W., to its junction with the Sheephorn Road in Section 13, T.2S., R.82W.

Sheephorn Road - No. 401 - From the gate near the Piney River Ranch in Section 21, T.2S., R.81W., to its junction with the Cottonwood Road in Section 13, T.2S., R.82W.

Shrine Pass Road - No. 709 - From the gate at the Forest boundary near its junction with Lime Creek Jeep Road No. 745 in Section 16, T.6S., R.80W., to the gate where it joins with the parking area near I-70 in Section 15, T.6S., R.79W.

Spraddle Creek Road - No. 737 - From the gate at the Spraddle Creek Livery Stable in Section 5, T.5S., R.80W., to its dead end in Section 34, T.4S., R.80W.

Tigiwon Road - No. 707 - From the gate at the Forest boundary above the tailings ponds area in Section 2 to its dead end at the Fall Creek Trailhead in Section 27, all in T.6S., R.81W.

The following road will be closed annually to all vehicles including snowmobiles operating on snow from one day after the close of the big game hunting season to July 1 (36 CFR 261.54 (b)).


Mill Creek Road - No. 710 - Beginning at the gate behind The Lodge at Vail in Section 7, T.5S., R.80W.

The following road will be closed annually to vehicles, except for snowmobiles operating on snow, beginning one day after the big game hunting season through one day prior to the big game hunting season (36 CFR 261.54 (b)).

Garden Gulch Road - No. 447 - Beginning at the Forest boundary in Section 8, T.2S., R.82W.

This order remains in effect until rescinded.
