FOREST DEVELOPMENT TRAILS
HOLY CROSS RANGER DISTRICT
WHITE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST


Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on the North Vail Trail, Forest Development Trail (FDT) 1896 (as shown on Exhibit A of this Order) within the White River National Forest, until further notice.

- (1) Using any motorized vehicle on the trail, except where the trail route follows existing roads (as shown on Exhibit A).
36 CFR 261.55(b).
- (2) Possessing a dog (except a working stock dog, a guide dog assisting a blind or disabled person, or a dog being used for legal hunting purposes) unless under physical restraint of a leash not longer than six (6) feet in length.
36 CFR 261.58(s).
- (3) Being on the trail, between April 15 and June 15 annually.
36 CFR 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:


- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
