

ORDER
TRAVEL REGULATIONS WITHIN VAIL PASS WINTER RECREATION AREA
WHITE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST


Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within the area known as the Vail Pass Winter Recreation Area within the White River National Forest. These prohibitions are in effect from December 1 to May 1 annually. All trails and use areas are shown on the map which is Attachment A of this Order.

- (1) Possessing or using a motorized vehicle off designated snowmobile trails, except within designated multiple use areas.
36 CFR 261.56.
- (2) Using a motorized vehicle on a designated cross country ski trail.
36 CFR 261.55(b).
- (3) Using any non-motorized mode of transportation on a designated snowmobile trail.
36 CFR 261.55(c).

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a USDA, Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
