

**TEMPORARY NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM TRAIL – RESTRICTIONS
USDA – FOREST SERVICE
SAN JUAN NATIONAL FOREST**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. §551 and 36 C.F.R. §261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on the Rincon La Osa Trail (National Forest System Trail # 525), in the Weminuche Wilderness Landscape on the Columbine Ranger District of the San Juan National Forest, Hinsdale County, State of Colorado, hereinafter referred to as the Restricted Trail.

The Restricted Trail is depicted on the attached map which is hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A. This Order is necessary for visitor protection on the Restricted Trail within the Weminuche Wilderness Landscape, prior to the implementation of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funded trail work.

PROHIBITIONS:

Using any stock animals on the Restricted Trail. 36 C.F.R. 261.55(c).

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt:

- (1) Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission;
- (2) Any Federal, State or local officer, or the member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and

This Order shall remain in effect until rescinded, or until December 31, 2010, whichever event occurs first.

Violations of these regulations is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. 16 U.S.C. 551, and 18, U.S.C. 3559 and 3571.
