As you know this past winter and spring we have received above average precipitation, which is a nice change from recent years. This above average precipitation should provide much needed relief to our perennial grasses which have been stressed due to drought conditions in recent years. However, cooler than normal soil temperatures has hindered plant growth creating range conditions that are not ready for livestock grazing.

Part 2 section 8(c) of your term grazing permit states, "When, in the judgment of the Forest Officer in charge, the forage is not ready to be grazed at the beginning of the designated grazing season, the permittee, upon request of the Forest officer, will defer placing livestock on the grazing allotment to avoid damage to the resources."
