

ORDER
SKIING CLOSURE - ALPINE AND CROSS COUNTRY
SKI APACHE RESORT
Lincoln National Forest
Smokey Bear Ranger District

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (a) to protect public safety, the following is prohibited adjacent to Ski Apache Resort as shown on Exhibit A.

The prohibitions are in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, 36 CFR.


(1) Alpine (downhill) or cross country skiing and/or snowboarding from within the developed and permitted area of the Ski Apache Resort to areas outside the boundary, 36 CFR 261.53(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order.

(1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

(2) Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
