

ORDER  
USE LIMITATIONS  
CAPITAN MOUNTAINS AND WHITE MOUNTAIN WILDERNESS AREAS  
Lincoln National Forest  
Smokey Bear Ranger District

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the Capitan Mountains and White Mountain Wilderness areas are closed to the prohibited activities listed below:

- (1) The possession of more than 15 pack and saddle stock for any overnight party entering the wilderness areas. Outfitter-guide parties, and all non-commercial parties with more than 5 pack and saddle stock, must carry and use processed stock feed, 36 CFR 261.53(b).
- (2) Storing equipment, personal property or supplies, 36 CFR 261.57(f).
- (3) Disposing of debris, garbage, or other waste, 36 CFR 261.57(g).
- (4) Possessing or using a wagon, cart or other vehicle (does not include non-motorized wheelchairs used by the physically challenged), 36 CFR 261.57(h).
- (5) Shortcutting a switchback in a trail, 36 CFR 261.55(e).


The prohibitions are in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, 36 CFR.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order.

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Affected Area: The entire area within the legal boundaries of the Capitan Mountains Wilderness and White Mountain Wilderness areas, Lincoln County, New Mexico as shown on the attached maps.


