

ORDER  
DEERHEAD, LOST LODGE DISPERSED USE AREAS  
Cloudcroft Ranger District  
Lincoln National Forest

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and 36 CFR 261.50 (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area described in this order within the Lincoln National Forest, until further notice:


- (1) Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire or stove fire, 36 CFR 261.52(a).
- (2) Camping, 36 CFR 261.58(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Affected Area: Either side of Forest Road 569 between Deerhead Campground and Lost Lodge Subdivision and in the area commonly known as Happy Valley (Attachment A, Map of Closure Area).



Violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of \$500 or imprisonment of not more than 6 months or both.


