

FOREST CLOSURE ORDER

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 36 CFR 261.50 (a), the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System lands within the Lincoln National Forest, State of New Mexico, until further notice:


- A. Forest Road 5619 on the Smokey Bear Ranger District is closed to motorized vehicle travel. [36 CFR 261.54 (e)]
- B. The use of motorized vehicles off of forest roads within the areas of the Cree Fire on the Smokey Bear Ranger District and Scott Able Fire on the Sacramento Ranger District, including firelines, temporary and closed roads, as shown on the attached maps. (36 CFR 261.56)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (2) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

This order becomes effective at 8:00 AM, Saturday, April 14, 2001, and will remain in force until rescinded.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than six months or both. USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571.
