

MCMA EE/CA Errata #1

EE/CA, page 9, Sensitive Species: This section is updated as follows for a current listing of various sensitive species that may be present in the MCMA--

- **Federally listed species**
 - spotted owl and critical habitat - historic sites
 - marbled murrelet and critical habitat - historic sites
 - grizzly bear and N. Cascades recovery zone
 - gray wolf

- **Regional Forester's Sensitive species**
 - Johnson's Hairstreak butterfly – present
 - bald eagle – not usually in the S.F. Sauk area (present in Sauk River drainage)
 - peregrine – potential – not likely to be impacted
 - harlequin duck – present- uses S.F. Sauk;
 - Townsend's big-eared bat – unknown
 - Wolverine – unknown – present in Glacier Peak Wilderness

- **MIS - Forest Management Indicator Species**
 - mountain goat – present
 - pine marten – likely present – Silver-fir habitat
 - black-tailed deer – present
 - pileated woodpecker – present – not likely to be impacted

- **Special status**
 - 6 mollusk species – not likely to be impacted
 - Neotropical Migratory Birds or landbirds
