SECOND DAM FIRE

Logan, Utah, July 19, 2010 – The Second Dam Fire was reported at 6:00 a.m. on Monday, July 19, 2010. The fire is located in Logan Canyon just south of Second Dam and is burning in heavy timber, in steep rugged terrain and is approximately 1 acre. Cause of the fire was lightning. Resources working on the fire include the 20 person Logan Hotshot crew and two helicopters, which are supporting the crew with water bucket drops. There are no structures threatened at this time.

The fire is extremely visible from Logan Canyon, (US Highway 89), and we are asking the public driving through the canyon to please not stop along the road to take pictures of the fire or just to watch the helicopter fire suppression activity. Also with the warmer temperatures please make sure that all campfires are out and cold to the touch before you leave your campsite, and remember with the 24th of July weekend coming up that fireworks are never allowed on public lands.
