BEAVER CREEK TRAIL

Difficulty: Moderate

Trail Use: Heavy

Length: 3.5 miles

Beginning Elevation: 8,400

Ending Elevation: 9,721

Access:

- From Rifle, go south under the I70 overpass and turn right at the first corner. Follow County Road 317 to Beaver Creek Trailhead at Forest Road #824

Trail Highlights:

A spectacular view of West Mamm, the Mamm Peaks, Roan Cliffs, Flat Tops, Mount Sopris, and the city of Rifle. There is an abundance of wildlife to be seen along this trail but keep in mind that this trail passes through private land so please do not go off trail.
