Difficulty: More Difficult

Trail Use: Light Length: 4.8 miles

Elevation: Starts 8,279 feet and ends 10,444 feet (highest point 10,499 feet)

Elevation Gain: +2,228 feet -63 feet =+2,165 feet

Open To: HIKING, HORSEBACK RIDING

Access:

- Park Creek Trail is located 36 miles east of Meeker.
- From Meeker, take State Highway 13 east for 1 mile.
- Where Highway 13 turns north, turn east on Rio Blanco County Road 8 for 18 miles.
- Turn south on Rio Blanco County Road 10 for 2 miles, jog north for 1/4 mile, then east for 10 miles to the South Fork Campground and trailhead.
- Follow the South Fork Trail 7 miles up the South Fork Canyon to the Park Creek Trail junction.

Trail Highlights:

You climb quickly out of South Fork for 1/2 mile and emerge into the open meadows along Park Creek. You continue in a large park for about 2 miles, then into a series of smaller parks broken by short stretches of aspen. The aspen gradually change to Englemann spruce and alpine fir as you gain elevation. You reach the Nichols Creek Trail 4.5 miles from the South Fork Trail and 11.5 miles from South Fork Campground.
