WEST MARVINE TRAIL #1868

Difficulty: Moderate

Trail Use: Moderate

Length: 6.3 miles, north fork; 6.75 miles, south fork

Elevation: North fk starts at 8,093 feet and ends at 8,283 feet (highest point 8,804 feet)
South fk starts at 8,093 feet and ends at 10,427 feet (highest point 10,427 feet)

Elevation Gain: +1,754 feet – 56 feet = +1,698 feet

Open To: HIKING, HORSEBACK RIDING

Access:

- West Marvine Trail is located 35 miles east of Meeker.
- From Meeker, take State Highway 13 east for 1 mile.
- Where Highway 13 turns north, turn east on Rio Blanco County Road 8 for 28 miles.
- Turn south at Fritzlans Guest Ranch, cross the bridge and turn east on the Marvine Creek Road (Rio Blanco County Road 12) for 6 miles to the Marvine Trailhead parking area. The West Marvine trailhead is not marked and may be difficult to find.

Trail Highlights:


The trail begins on an old logging road on the west side of the road before you get to the corrals. It crosses Marvine Creek just below the fork of East Marvine Creek. The trail then climbs the ridge and crosses West Marvine Creek following House Creek to where the trail branches to the north and south about 2 miles from the trailhead. The north fork of West Marvine Trail follows the ridge below Camel Peak for 4.3 miles until its junction with Ute Creek Trail #1824 approximately 2 miles from the Ute Creek Trailhead. The trail skirts private property. The south fork of West Marvine Trail follows West Marvine Creek upstream for about 4.75 miles until its junction with the Ute Creek Trail.




