Length: 2.53 miles (one-way)

Elevation: Starts at 9,134 feet and ends at 9,918 feet (highest point 9,988 feet)

Elevation Gain: +859 feet -75 feet =+784 feet

Open To: SNOWMOBILING, CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING, SNOWSHOEING

Access:

- From I-70 take Exit 203, Frisco / Breckenridge, and travel south on HWY 9 toward Breckenridge.
- From the Main Street and Summit Boulevard (HWY 9) traffic light continue for .5 miles to the next traffic light (the County Commons entrance).
- Turn right at the traffic light, which is County Road 1004. Follow this road for approximately 200 yards and turn right, then an immediate left turn.
- Continue on this road for another .5 miles and there is a parking area next to a gate. Park and unload here.

Trail Highlights:

- The trail continues up past the gate and along the bike path.
- Follow the road up and across the bike path. Your first attraction will be Rainbow Lake, which is on the right-hand side.
- You will notice the Peaks Trail. <u>THIS TRAIL IS FOR CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING AND SNOW-SHOEING ONLY!!</u>

Important Information:
