3 - VAIL PASS WINTER RECREATION AREA

Difficulty: EASY TO MORE DIFFICULT

Trail Use: Moderate to Heavy

Length: Varies depending on trail

Elevation: Varies depending on trail

Elevation Gain: Varies depending on trail

Open To: SNOWMOBILING, CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING, SNOWSHOEING

Access:

- From I-70 take Exit 190, Vail Pass Rest Area, and go to the rest area on the west side of I-70. Park in the designated area.
