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ROCKY FORK TRAIL, #1931: NON-WILDERNESS

Length: 9.0/14.4 mi/km

ACCESS: From Carbondale travel east on Hwy 82 to Basalt. Turn left at the stoplight and travel 13 miles up the Fryingpan River Road. Take a right at the anglers access road below the Ruedi Dam, cross the river and follow the road to the left until it dead ends at the trailhead.

NARRATIVE: This trail is fairly steep for the first half mile, then levels off to a gradual climb until it connects with Road #528. Fishing is fair in the stream for Brook Trout.
