CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING

ADVANCED

PERSEVERANCE: A great, hilly trail through the trees, ending up over Gracie's cabin on the Snowmass Club track system. You can finish this run by skiing down off the trail through the open meadow above Gracie's.

TWISTER: A good wooded trail which explores some of the hills above the Owl Creek Trail. Twister offers an excellent diversion for advanced skiers who are skiing Owl Creek.

FISK/TELEGRAPH HILL: A seldom skied trail combination at Ashcroft Ski Touring, but one not to be missed! This route winds up and down through some of the most beautiful stands of aspen in the Aspen area. The hills are very challenging but the area's beauty makes you quickly forget the difficulty.

DIFFICULT TRAIL: A steep and narrow trails in the woods along Difficult Creek, rising up from Difficult Campground east of Aspen. There are no set tracks— this is backcountry skiing for experienced skiers.
