## Siskiyou County Resource Advisory Committee to Meet August 16 at the Yreka High School Library

YREKA, Calif.—The Siskiyou County Resource Advisory Committee (RAC) will meet on August 16, 2010 at the Yreka High School Library, 400 Preece Way, Yreka. The meeting will convene at 4:00 p.m. and usually ends before 8:00 p.m. The public is invited to attend and make comment.

The RAC is federally sanctioned by the Secretary of the Department of Agriculture and was formed as a result of the Secure Rural Schools and Community Self-Determination Act of 2000. The RAC is a local advisory committee that recommends projects to federal land managers which will benefit resources on public lands. The fifteen member group represents a cross section of county communities, industries, schools, environmentalists, and local government.

The agenda includes project updates and financial status, public comment period, and review of new project proposals to be considered by the RAC.
