## Klamath National Forest Announces Fire Restrictions

**Yreka, CA-** Effective Tuesday, August 10, 2010 the Klamath National Forest has applied special fire restrictions on the national forest because of the risk of large fires due to very dry conditions in the forest. The fire prevention measures will continue through November 1, 2010 (or until the high fire danger subsides), Patricia Grantham, Klamath National Forest Supervisor, announced today.

“Concentrating open campfires in designated recreational sites should help minimize the potential of accidentally starting a wildland fire,” said Grantham.

Fire restrictions include:

- Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire, except in the Trinity Alps, Russian, Marble Mountain and Siskiyou Wilderness Areas and Designated Recreation Sites.
- Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or a building, within the Designated Recreation Sites, or while stopped in an area at least three feet in diameter that is barren of all flammable material.
- Welding, or operating an acetylene torch with an open flame.
- Using an explosive.
- Operating an internal combustion engine, except on National Forest System roads or trails, or within the Designated Recreation Sites.

Exempted from the restrictions are:

- Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission. Persons with a valid California Campfire Permit are not exempt from the prohibitions listed above. However, persons with a valid California Campfire Permit may use a portable stove or lantern using gas, jellied petroleum, or pressurized liquid fuel.
- Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Persons violating these restrictions may be subject to a fine, six months in jail, or both. If a person is found to have caused a wildfire anywhere on the national forest, they can be held liable for suppression costs.
