

Peck Lake Salvage Timber Sale Highlights

- **Sale is located approximately 6 miles south of Sidnaw, Michigan, going east on FR 2400 (Norway Lake Road) for approximately 1.0 - 1.5 miles (north and south sides of FR 2400).**
- **Normal Operating Season is year round (except during spring breakup)**
- **There are no Purchaser Deposits for Road Maintenance with this Timber Sale.**
- **FR 2400 (Norway Lake Road) is maintained by Houghton County.**
- **Approximately 10.4% of the sale volume is Red & White Pine Sawtimber, 66.7% is jack pine pulpwood.**
- **There was a risk adjustment applied to the jack pine pulpwood due to high risk for mortality and the red & white pine sawtimber due to Ips pine beetle presence.**
