



Order No. 19-10-05
USDA Forest Service
Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit
Angora Hazard Tree Removal Project

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit. This Order is effective from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., July 29 through October 7, 2010.

1. Being within 300 feet of Forest Trail No. 17E49 (Gunmount Trail) from its intersection with Tahoe Boulevard, then south 1¼ mile to its intersection with Angora Creek, as shown on Exhibit 1. 36 CFR 261.53(e).
2. Being on Forest Trail No. 17E49 (Gunmount Trail) from its intersection with Tahoe Boulevard, then south 1¼ mile to its intersection with Angora Creek, as shown on Exhibit 1. 36 CFR 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.


These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
