Forest Sponsors Weed Roundup in the North Fork

The Flathead National Forest, working in partnership with the North Fork Landowners Association, will host a free weed roundup on Monday, July 26 at Sondreson Hall from 9:30am-3pm. Participants will learn about weed identification and options for treatment, as well as help with some weed pulling. A slide show by Edwin Knox of Waterton Park and a presentation about medicinal uses of weeds by National Public Radio's Flora de la Terre will be presented.

Participants are encouraged to bring work gloves and water. Lunch will be provided.

The partnership between the Forest Service and the North Fork Landowners Association is focused on mapping and treating noxious weeds in the North Fork area, and providing educational resources for landowners.

A grant from the Flathead National Forest-Flathead County Resource Advisory Council is helping support the partnership.
