

**Special Road Restrictions and Intermittent Road Closure Order
For National Forest System Roads (NFSR) 321 and 321.1B
During Construction Activities Associated With the SourceGas Pipeline Construction Project
Sopris Ranger District
White River National Forest
Pitkin County, Colorado**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50 (b) the following acts are prohibited on the described National Forest System Roads (NFSR) located within the Sopris Ranger District, White River National Forest, Pitkin County, Colorado, hereinafter referred to as the Restricted Roads. The Restricted Roads are also depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A. This Order shall be in effect beginning approximately August 1, 2010 and continue until rescinded or until December 31, 2010, whichever event occurs first. The closure may be intermittent and effective only during times when pipeline construction activities are occurring.

The purpose of this Order is to protect public health and safety during commercial natural gas operations associated with pipeline construction between Well #9 and Well # 712D.

The Restricted Roads are further defined as follows:

1. National Forest System Road (NFSR) 321 - Vehicle travel will be prohibited from the entrance to SourceGas well pad #71 (SW ¼ of Section 36, T8S, R90W) east to the termination of NFSR 321 at Forest Service Trail N1943W.3.
2. National Forest System Road (NFSR) 321.1B - Vehicle travel will be prohibited from the intersection of NFSR 321 and NFSR 321.1B (SW ¼ of Section 36, T8S, R90W) north to the termination of NFSR 321.1B at pad #14.
3. NFSR 321 and NFSR 321.1B (non-motorized use) - The public will be authorized to access the general forest area around the closed portion of the road via foot or horse for hiking or riding, respectively, around the areas where pipeline construction activities will be present. Parking for non-vehicle access around these locations is permitted if a vehicle can be effectively and safely parked near the subject roads.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Using any motorized vehicle on the Restricted Roads when road closure devices and signs are in place, beginning approximately August 1, 2010 and continue until rescinded or until December 31, 2010, whichever event occurs first. (36 C.F.R. § 261.54(a))

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.




Violations of these prohibitions are punishable as a Class B Misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, and 3571)
