

# CHUGACH NATIONAL FOREST

Order No. 10-04-00-10-07

## Forest Supervisor's Order **DEVELOPED RECREATION SITES** & **PUBLIC RECREATION USE CABINS**

Pursuant to 36 Code of Federal Regulations 261.50 (a) and (b) the following acts are prohibited as described below, within the Chugach National Forest Developed Recreation Sites including Public Recreation Use Cabins. These restrictions are in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, and become effective when signed and will remain in effect until rescinded.

### **36 CFR 261.53 – Special Closures:**

**For public health and safety [Title 36, 261.53(e)]**

Cutting a standing tree within 150 feet of any developed site.

### **36 CFR 261.58 – Occupancy and Use:**

**Camping [Title 36, 261.58(e)]**

Camping, pitching tent or staying over night within 300 feet of any Public Recreation Use Cabin, unless they are a member of the registered party for that specific cabin during the permitted dates.

### **36 CFR 261.58 – Occupancy and Use:**

**Using a campsite or other described in the order by more than the number of users allowed by the order [Title 36, 261.58(f)]**

Occupying a single camp unit with more than eight individuals or sixteen for designated double camp units or occupying a Public recreation Use Cabin with more than eight individuals per cabin for each permitted day. Except for Spencer Glacier Developed Recreation Area where it is permitted to have 15 occupants at camp site (node) A and 10 occupants at camp site (node) B.

### **36 CFR 261.58 – Occupancy and Use:**

**Parking or leaving a vehicle in violation of posted instructions [Title 36, 261.58(g)]**

### **36 CFR 261.58 – Occupancy and Use:**

**Parking or leaving a vehicle outside a parking space assigned to one's own camp unit [Title 36, 261.58(h)]**

### **36 CFR 261.58 – Occupancy and Use:**

**Possessing, storing, or transporting any bird, fish, or other animal or parts thereof, as specified by the order [Title 36, 261.58(s)]**

Possessing, leaving unattended, or cleaning any animal carcass at or on a picnic table or camp site unless the carcass is being prepared for immediate consumption.

### **36 CFR 261.58 – Occupancy and Use:**

**Being in the area between 10:00 p.m. and 6 a.m. except a person who is camping or who is visiting a person camping in that area [Title 36, 261.58(u)]**

## 36 CFR 261.58 – Occupancy and Use:

### **Riding, hitching, tethering or hobbling a horse or other saddle or pack animal in violation of posted instructions [Title 36, 261.58(aa)]**

Riding, hitching, tethering or hobbling any saddle or pack animal including dog teams, within 200 feet of a Forest Public Use Cabin, established trails, water source, or developed recreation site.

#### **Definitions:**

1. **“Developed recreation site”** means an area which has been improved or developed for recreation.
2. **“Animal carcass”** means the dead body or parts thereof of any animal, bird, or fish, including domestic livestock.
3. **“Camping/sleeping area”** means National Forest System Lands temporarily used for the purpose of overnight occupancy without a permanently fixed structure or lands temporarily occupied by unattended camping equipment.


#### **Exceptions:**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following are exempt from this order:


1. Any person with a permit authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local law enforcement officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

#### **Penalty:**

Violations of these Prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. [16 U.S.C. 551, and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571]
